Who are CleanupUK

CleanupUK is a passionate charity with a big heart and an even bigger goal – to create a UK where everybody has access to litter-free spaces.

CleanupUK plays a pivotal role in curbing and preventing litter by focusing on fostering behaviour change. Through leading by example and empowering local volunteers to establish and maintain litter-picking groups, our efforts target two fundamental reasons behind littering: the notion that it's acceptable because others do it and the belief that an area is already littered, so further littering doesn't matter.

We focus on social cohesion, connecting people and helping to create a greater sense of pride in local areas.

We make litter-picking a fun, community activity, motivating and enabling people to do something to improve the places they care about.





How CleanupUK Are Delivering Impact

Community Cleanup Hubs

Community Cleanup Hubs Cleanup Hubs address the harmful, far-reaching impact of litter in the depletion of England's most disadvantaged areas.

We set up partnerships with local organisations nationwide to establish Community Cleanup Hubs in areas needing attention. These Cleanup Hubs are equipped with essential litter-picking gear, which is made available for free borrowing to their network of individuals and anyone else in the community.

<u>We currently have over 82 Cleanup hubs across England – we aim to create Cleanup</u> <u>Hubs in the 100 most deprived areas of England.</u>

Supporting litter-picking groups UK-wide

In addition to our Cleanup Hubs in deprived areas, we also unite and support like-minded individuals UK-wide to set up and sustain their own litter-picking groups to clean up their communities. We offer a step-by-step guide and a range of other resources on our website, to help people start litter picking locally and attract new members. Groups also get to join the extensive CleanupUK network, where they can share all the amazing work that they are doing.





Meet Helen - A Community Champion

Helen is the heart and soul behind many environmental activities at Jubilee Crescent Cleanup Hub in Radford, Coventry. As the Cleanup Hub Coordinator, she is remarkable at keeping her community clean and connected. Not only is she an active litter picker, but Helen is also a passionate volunteer for various environmental organisations, leading by example and inspiring others to do the same.

Helen's litter-picking journey began during lockdown, initially to get outdoors. But for Helen, it's about more than just picking up litter—it's about rekindling community spirit where people look out for each other, are friends with their neighbours and take care of the spaces they share. She hopes to pass on these values to the children and young people she works with at the Jubilee Community Centre, hoping to instill in them a love for their environment just as she was taught.

One of Helen's proudest achievements was organising the Radford Big Tidy, a large-scale cleanup event that brought together community groups, litter-pickers, and local businesses. This united effort targeted a long-standing fly-tipping hotspot in Jubilee Crescent, an area notorious for anti-social behaviour.



The Big Tidy, was a great success! We filled an entire truck with waste which has already made a massive improvement to the area" While there's still more to be done, the success of the event proved that when people come together, they can create real, lasting change. Helen is now working hard to encourage even more volunteers to join her mission and continue transforming Jubilee Crescent.
