

MAKE A WILD NATURE CROWN!

Spend time outdoors collecting natural treasures to create your nature crown. While you explore, if you spot any litter, pick it up and pop it in the bin to help keep nature clean and safe for wildlife.

You will need:

- A strip of cardboard (from a cereal box works well!)
- String or tape
- Scissors (ask an adult to help)
- Leaves
- Flowers
- Grass or long stems
- Small twigs (optional)
- Glue or sticky tape

STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Head out into nature to gather treasures for your crown!

2. Make your base



Measure around your head with the card and cut a strip to fit. Tape or glue the ends together to make a crown shape.

3. Collect nature treasures



Collect leaves and flowers from outside.

4. Attach your treasures



Attach them to your crown using glue.

5. Wrap and weave



You could wrap string around your crown and attach more things like feathers.

TIPS



Use a mix of colours and shapes.



Be gentle with nature, take only what you need.
